Tues., June 16: Miles City, MT We depart this morning for the Pacific Northwest on a tour that is full of beautiful scenery, exploring magnificent mountains, forests and the areas of British Columbia, Washington, Oregon & more. As we head west today, we will travel to the Big Sky Country of Montana, staying in Miles City, MT for the evening.

Wed., June 17: Wallace, ID (B,D) A travel day west passing through Billings, Bozeman, and Missoula and in to IDAHO. We will overnight in Wallace, ID, a historic mining town in the Silver Valley. Lodging at the Wallace Inn with an evening meal included.

Thurs., June 18: Leavenworth, WA (B) Traveling a short distance and stop at Lake Coeur d'Alene, a large, scenic lake known for its stunning scenery and rich history with mining and logging here. We will cross in to Washington and soon in Spokane. We are in the midst of the beautiful Cascade Mtn. Range. We will make a stop in Wenatchee, WA, known as the "Apple Capital of the World," located on the Columbia and Wenatchee rivers. Then on to the Bavarian Alpine village of Leavenworth, WA for our lodging to night at the Bavarian Lodge in the heart of Leavenworth. The evening is on your own to explore and dine in this German style Bavarian Theme town. Originally, a logging town call Icicle along the Icicle River.

Lodging in Seattle.

Sat., June 20: Vancouver, BC (B,L) A local guide will join us this morning for a tour of Seattle. Seattle is known as the "Emerald City" and is surrounded by water and mountains. We will learn of its history with the - lumber-industry boom, the Klondike Gold Rush, the Boeing boom and more as the founding of this city dates back to 1851. Heading north, we will stop for an Included lunch in Mt. Vernon, WA. We will continue on Hwy 5, crossing into CANADA, on our way to Vancouver, BC for the evening (Require Passports or Enhanced Drivers license for crossing the border.) Vancouver is a bustling west coast seaport in British Columbia. Was the host city for the 2010 Olympic Winter games. Enjoy a relaxing evening here in Vancouver.

Sun., June 21: Victoria, BC (2 nights) (B,D) A local guide will join us for a tour around Vancouver, through Stanley Park, Queen Elizabeth Park, Gastown & more. Later, we board the B. C. Ferry taking us on an hour and half ride to Swartz Bay in Sidney, BC on Vancouver Island. From here we will board our bus to Victoria, BC for 2 nights at the Victoria Marriott Inner Harbour. Victoria is British Columbia's beautiful and charming capital city on the southeast tip of the Island. It is a major port with two harbors and a distinct English flavor. Dinner is included tonight.

Mon., June 22: Victoria, BC (B) A local guide will join us this morning for a city tour of Victoria which began as an outpost for Hudson Bay Co., in 1843. We will view the Parliament Buildings, Christ Church Cathedral and other historical sights. Then we will go to the BUTCHART GARDENS. Enjoy lunch here on your own before strolling along the pathways of this 55 acres of gardens featuring different styles of landscapes, masterfully displayed with thousands of flowers in various garden settings. Later, we return to Victoria and the hotel for a free evening to enjoy the area.

Tues., June 23: Chehalis, WA (B,D) We return to the states today --Passports or Enh. license needed We will board the Black Ball Ferry taking us to Port Angeles, WA (1 ½ hr ride). About a 3 hr drive will take us to Chehalis, WA for the evening on your own.

Wed., June 24: Cascade Locks, OR (B,D) As we travel today, we will stop at the Mt St Helen's Visitor Center then go through Portland to beautiful Multnomah Falls. Oregon's tallest waterfalls. Walk to the base of the falls, where water cascades from its 620-foot drop. Time given for lunch on your own at the Lodge, We will then follow up Hwy 84 to Cascade Locks and take a narrated Expedition Cruise on the Columbia Gorge. After the cruise, we will check in to our lodging here and enjoy an Included meal at a local restaurant.

Thurs., June 25: Missoula, MT (B) We will follow the Columbia Gorge River & cross the river and then catch I-90 to Spokane, WA. ***For those that wish, we can help set up a flight back to Minneapolis from Spokane, let us know. The tour will keep going and make stops as need to Missoula, MT for the night.

Fri., June 26: Buffalo, WY (B, D) Continuing our travels, we will visit Little Bighorn National Monument which preserves the site of the June 25 & 26, 1876 Battle of Little Bighorn. Lunch will be included. Then continue to Buffalo, WY for the evening on your own.

Sat., June 27: Rapid City, SD (B) Leaving Buffalo, we will head to the Black Hills of SD. We will spend some time in Deadwood for lunch and time on own here. Then visit famous Mt Rushmore, with the 60 ft high faces of Presidents George Washington, Thomas Jefferson, Theodore Roosevelt, and Abraham Lincoln which was completed in 1941.
